



## Amarr, P1 Group, and Peaslee Tech Develop an Emergency Shelter

Inspired by the ongoing need for emergency shelters in Douglas County, the concept of locally sourced shelters was researched in THE CRUNCH, Peaslee's business ignitor and prototyping center. Peaslee partnered with Amarr & P1 to develop a prototype using garage doors manufactured in Lawrence. The result was the "Rapid Room", an 8'x8'x8' structure that can be assembled and disassembled quickly. The room is extremely well insulated and is weather resistant.
