ON CAMPUS CAREER COURSES

ADVANCED WELDING

Out of position Welding, mainly 4G. It will have the 3 major welding process: SMAW, GMAW, GTAW, also welding non-ferrous metals

AUTOCAD

Through a combination of lectures, hands-on exercises, and drawing problems, this course prepares the learner as an entry-level AutoCAD Technician.

AUTO SERVICE TECH

This program is designed to prepare an individual with the foundational training to develop, through experience and training, into a skilled automotive technician.

CARPENTRY

The program is designed to prepare an individual with the foundational training to develop, through experience, into a skilled residential carpenter.

CDL-A CLASS

CDL-A: Prepares participants to drive multispeed transmission tractor and trailer, vehicle, and log maintenance, and required skills to work as an over-the-road driver.

COURT REPORTER (VOICE)

This course is available in class or on live video and is designed to bring the student proficiency level needed to pass the required examinations. The course includes modules which will enable beginning court reporters to enter the field with a broad understanding of the profession.

INTRODUCTION TO WELDING

Instruction using layout tools with demonstration and guided practices using some of the following welding processes: shield metal arc welding (SMAW), gas metal arc welding (GMAW), Gas tungsten arc welding (GTAW), along with layout, cutting and grinding or any other approved welding process. Cutting practice will be covered by using a portable cutter and tract torch.

INTERMEDIATE WELDING

The purpose of the Intermediate Welding is to build on the skills learned from the Introductory level by adding horizontal (2G) and vertical (3G) welding positions to electric arc and gas welding.

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN

Course content is designed to provide participants with the knowledge needed to assist pharmacists in preparing and dispensing medication in retail and hospital pharmacies as well as collecting patient info for prescription and billing.

RESIDENTIAL ELECTRICIAN

The program is designed to prepare an individual with the foundational training to develop, through experience and training, into a skilled residential Electrician

RESIDENTIAL HVAC

The one-year program is designed to prepare an individual with the foundational training to develop, through experience and training, into a skilled residential mechanical technician.

RESIDENTIAL PLUMBING

The one-year program is designed to prepare an individual with the foundational training to develop, through experience, into a skilled residential plumber.
